



Potential Exporters Sought

Bingen, Washington – The Port of Klickitat, Klickitat County Economic Development Dept., Mt. Adams Chamber of Commerce, and Goldendale Chamber of Commerce are seeking companies that would like to expand their market reach by launching or expanding the sale of their products to customers outside the U.S. “We are working with each other and the Washington Small Business Development Center (WSBDC) to host a half-day 'Introduction to Exporting' seminar for local firms,” said Mt. Adams' Director, Avery Pickard. The seminar is part of the WSBDC's export education program that focuses on working with new-to-export and new-to-market companies with little or no expertise in international trade.

“This is a great opportunity for any small business that is considering selling abroad, but is either unsure how best to do it or concerned about the perceived risks,” said Marc Thornsby, the Port's Executive Director. “If there is sufficient interest, the seminar will be held at the port office in Bingen, Washington, in early September and cover topics such as Export Channel Selection and Trade Finance Options.”

A fee of \$29 will be charged to participants and class size is limited. Firms interested in attending the seminar are asked to contact the Port (509-493-1655), County (509-773-7060), Mt. The Washington SBDC Export Readiness program is part of a statewide export initiative sponsored through a grant by the Washington State Community Economic Revitalization Board which is administrated by the Washington Department of Commerce. The Washington SBDC has also partnered with the Washington State University Impact Center to assist with agricultural research and with the International Trade Alliance in Spokane to offer export workshops across the state.
