



## **SAO Completes Triennial Port Audit**

**Bingen, Washington** – The Washington State Auditor's Office (SAO) has released the results of the performance audit it conducted for the Port of Klickitat in October of this year. The SAO's stated mission is to promote accountability, fiscal integrity, and openness in state and local government as well as the efficient and effective use of public resources. The Port is currently audited on a three-year cycle with the prior audit having been completed in 2010.

The report, covering the years 2010 through 2012, states in part, "In the areas we examined, the Port's internal controls were adequate to safeguard public assets. The Port also complied with state laws and regulations and its own policies and procedures in the areas we examined."

"I am proud of the results of our most recent audit and of the fact the Port has had no findings for as far back as the Auditor's Office has current records [1993]," said Port Commissioner Jim Herman. "Our history of clean audits serves as evidence of our commitment to accountability and transparency in service to our constituents."

Though the audits performed serve to protect the public interest, they are not without cost. "Our bill for this latest audit is expected to be over \$8,000," said Marc Thornsby, the Port's Executive Director. "However, that figure does not include the hours of staff time needed to provide documentation and other information requested by SAO personnel."

Economic development, transportation, and marine-based recreation are key functions of the Port of Klickitat. These are achieved through leasing industrial-zoned property, developing and renting industrial and commercial facilities, developing and maintaining rail spurs and dock facilities, assisting companies with an interest in locating in Klickitat County, creating and managing marine-based recreational facilities, and working closely with various partner organizations and agencies.

The Port of Klickitat is located in Klickitat County, Washington and was created in 1944. It is one of several port authorities located in the mid-Columbia region. It owns two industrial parks and several buildings, leases industrial property and space, operates a barge dock, and holds property set aside for a park and marina. Transportation access is provided via rail, river barge, highways 14, 35, and 197, and Interstate 84.
