Port Park To Close For Event

Bingen, Washington – The Port of Klickitat's Sailboard Park located at Bingen Point will be closed on Saturday, June 29, 2019, for the “Rock the Point” event being held by the United Way of the Columbia Gorge. However, Marina Park will remain open to the public and visitors are encouraged to use this alternate site located 0.3 miles north of, and across Bingen Harbor from, Sailboard Park during its closure.

“Bingen Point is a great setting in which to offer this kind of entertainment to the residents of our greater community and we are pleased to provide a venue for it again this year,” said Marc Thornsby, the Port's Executive Director. Closing the park will be inconvenient for some, but Thornsby hopes local residents will see it as a worthwhile exchange for the chance to enjoy good music and start summer off supporting a good cause.
