A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY
(COLBY GANTRY CRANE)**

WHEREAS, the Klickitat County Port District No. 1 may sell and convey any of its real or personal property valued at less than an estimated value of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) pursuant to RCW 39.33.010 and 39.33.020 without a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Klickitat County Port District No. 1 has determined that the Port's Colby Gantry Crane SN 216, Model 240, located at the Dallesport Industrial Park's Barge Dock Facility, requires approximately \$150,000 in repairs in order to bring the crane to a certifiable condition; and

WHEREAS, the Klickitat County Port District No. 1 has determined that it is presently beyond the Port's financial capacity to repair the crane to a certifiable condition, under WAC 296-56, Longshore and Waterfront Operations; and

WHEREAS, the Klickitat County Port District No. 1 has determined that there is presently no one who is qualified (as a certified operator) to operate the crane for the Port, nor is there presently any interested company who wishes to utilize the crane to move commodities for the Port's benefit; and

WHEREAS, Dallesport Log Yard (present users of the Barge Dock Facility) have indicated that the crane's location is hindering their operations in loading log barges for Weyerhaeuser Corp.; and


WHEREAS, the Port of Clarkston has been contacted, as interest had been expressed for the possible use of this crane, however, they are not interested in acquiring this equipment; and


WHEREAS, the Klickitat County Port District No. 1, by motion on November 21, 2000 declared the property to be no longer needed for district purposes.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Klickitat County Port District No. 1 Board of Commissioners does hereby authorize that the Colby Gantry Crane be considered surplus property and authorizes that it be sold or scrapped. Any sale proceeds will be remitted to the Port of Vancouver, pursuant to the Port of Klickitat's and Port of Vancouver's agreement, in which the Port of Vancouver forgave the Port of Klickitat's balance due of \$65,000. of their debt associated with the transport and set up of this crane.
