WHEREAS, public notices were published in a newspaper of general circulation in Klickitat County during the weeks of October 21 and October 28, 2013, stating that the preliminary budget was available for inspection and that a public hearing on the proposed budget would be held at the Port Office on November 5, 2013 at 4:30 P.M. pursuant to RCW 53.35.020; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held November 5, 2013, at the Port Office at which time the Port Commission accepted comment from all persons desiring to be heard on the matter of the operating, maintenance, and capital budgets for the year 2014 pursuant to RCW 53.35.030;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Port of Klickitat does hereby accept, approve, and adopt the operating, maintenance, and capital budgets for the year 2014, a certified copy of which shall be filed with the Clerk of the Klickitat County Board of Commissioners pursuant to RCW 53.35.045 and a summary of which is shown below:
